RULES AND REGULATIONS ORAL PRESENTATION

2nd FALETEHAN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE 2025

These guidelines ensure a smooth, professional, and engaging experience for all oral presenters and attendees.

- 1. Presenters are required to enter the designated Zoom meeting room (details will be provided one day before the event) 30 minutes before their scheduled presentation time.
- 2. Please rename your Zoom account using the format: [Your Name]_[Your Institution]. For example: Fairus Sintawati Universitas Faletehan.
- 3. Presenters and participants **must keep their microphones muted** when not speaking to prevent background noise and ensure clear audio for the active speaker.
- 4. Presenters **must use the virtual background provided by the committee**. Please ensure your lighting is adequate for the virtual background to display correctly.
- 5. Presenters are required to **fill out the attendance list** shared by the committee during the conference.
- 6. Presenters are expected to **dress neatly and professionally**, as you would for an in-person conference.
- 7. Oral presentations must be delivered in English and should be 10 minutes in length.

 Please practice to ensure you stay within the time limit.
- 8. Each presentation will be followed by a **5-minute Q&A session**. The session moderator will facilitate questions from the audience.
- 9. Presenters **must keep their camera turned on throughout their presentation** and during the Q&A session. This helps maintain engagement and connection with the audience.

PARALLEL SESSION PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- 1. All presenters must use the virtual background provided on the WhatsApp Group.
- 2. The presenter must be one of the authors of the paper.
- 3. Presentations may be delivered in either English or Indonesian.
- 4. Presenters must prepare a PowerPoint presentation file with a maximum of 10 slides.
- 5. The parallel session will be led by a Moderator/Session Chair appointed by the committee.
- 6. The presentation material will be screen-shared by either the host or the presenter.
- 7. The presentation should be conducted in a maximum of 10 minutes, and 5 minutes for discussion session.
- 8. Due to the limited time, each presenter is encouraged to manage their time effectively and focus on the research findings, discussion, and the urgency of their study.
- 9. To assist with time management, a timer will be displayed during the presentation. Presenters are expected to pay attention to the timer to ensure their presentation does not exceed the allotted time.
- 10. The moderator has the right to cut off the presentation or discussion if it exceeds the allotted time.
